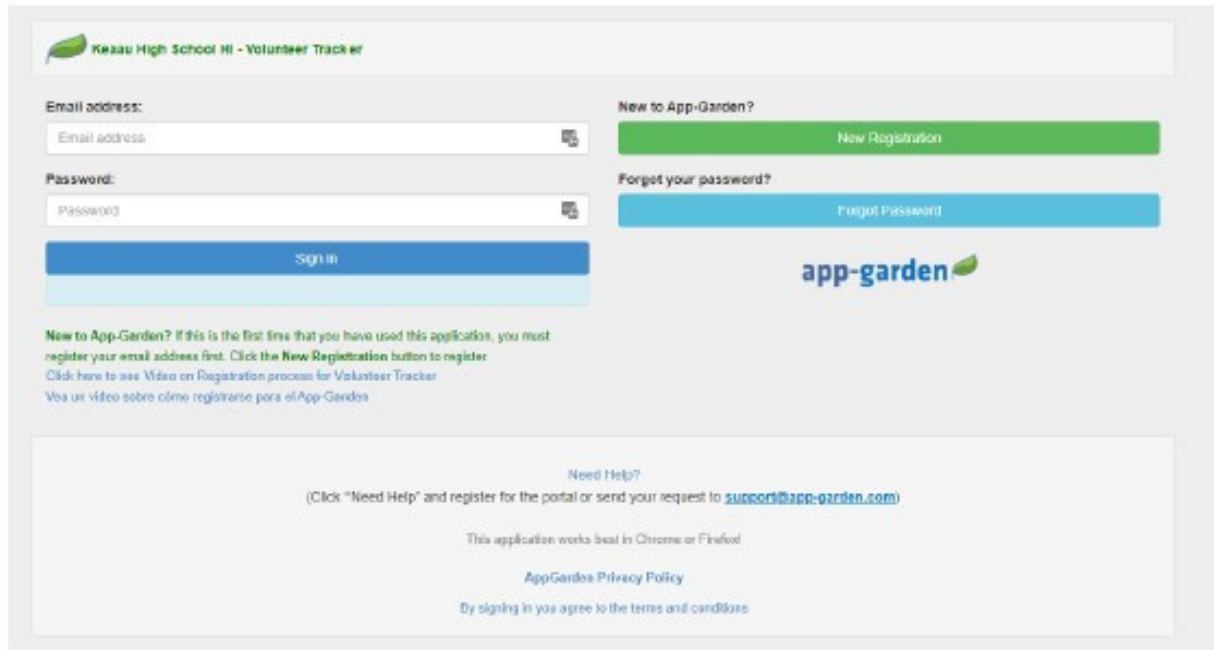
How to Register

The first time you access the system you will need to click on the registration link to register your email address and create a password. Click on the:

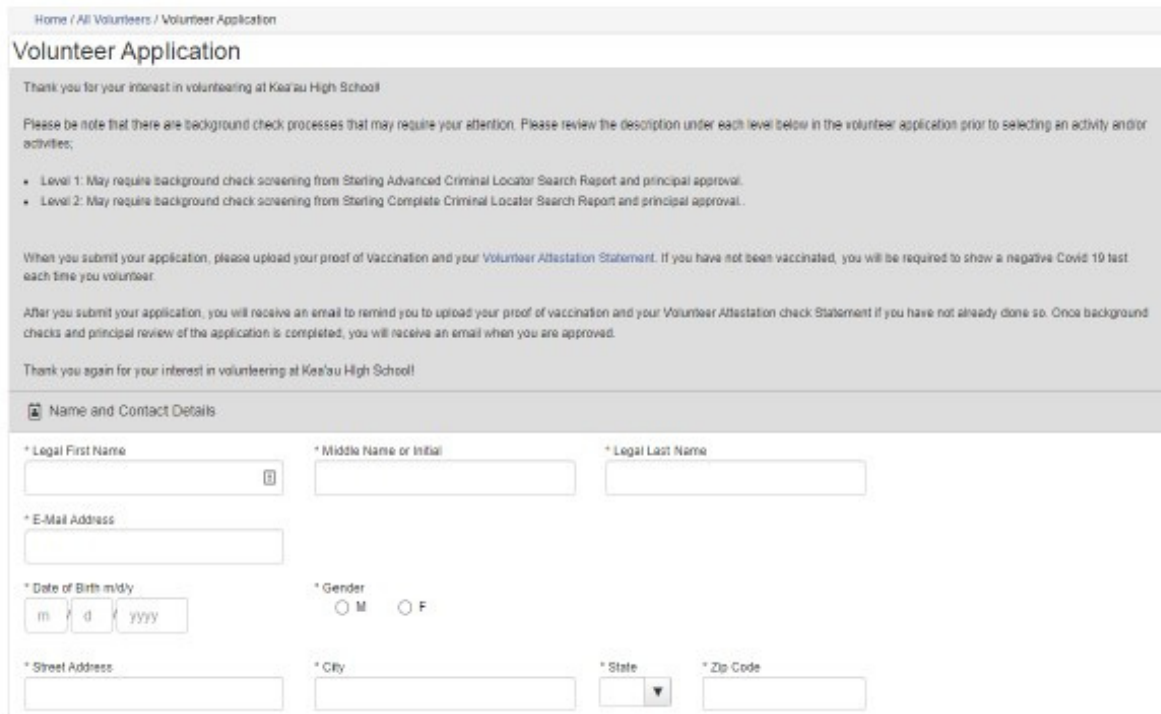
