

Welcome to Achieve3000!

We are excited that your child will have the opportunity to build their Literacy skills with Achieve3000 Literacy this school year! Your child's first step will be to complete LevelSet. If your child is taking this assessment at home instead of at school, please review these important points to help prepare:

What is LevelSet?

The LevelSet is an assessment to measure your child's reading ability and to place your child at **their** just-right reading level. Your child will take the Achieve3000 LevelSet in order to establish their initial Lexile measure.

What is a Lexile?

A Lexile measure is a valuable tool for teachers, parents, and students. It serves two unique functions: it is the measure of how **difficult a text** is as well as a measure of a **student's reading ability level**. The Lexile Framework was developed by MetaMetrics[®], an educational assessment and research team.

How should my child prepare for LevelSet?

It is important to prepare students for LevelSet in order to ensure the most accurate baseline Lexile measure. In order to help your child prepare for the assessment, we recommend:

- Make sure they receive plenty of rest the night before LevelSet.
- Make sure they eat a healthy meal or snack prior to the testing session.
- Find a quiet space and a comfy chair. Anticipate the LevelSet to take about 15-40 minutes.
- Show students the LevelSet tutorial so that they know what to expect on the test and how their scores will be used.

How can my child access the LevelSet assessment?

- Your child will access Achieve3000 via portal.achieve3000.com or by following any specific instructions sent by your child's teacher. LevelSet will automatically begin the first time they log in to Achieve3000 Literacy.

What are some tips to help my child be successful when taking the LevelSet assessment?

- Encourage your child to take their time on each question. They should read the entire paragraph, the question, and all four answer choices, before selecting the best answer. Click on the letter next to the word they think fits into the blank line. If your child is not sure about an answer, they should select the choice they think fits best.
- LevelSet will not indicate if your child's responses are correct or incorrect. After they select an answer choice and hit Submit, they will simply move on to the next question.

- Let your child know they will answer between 30-40 questions. They cannot go back to change an answer on a previous question, so it is important to take their time and read carefully before choosing the best answer.
- Because this is a reading test, let your child know that **you cannot help with the questions**. They should try their best to answer independently.
- Quietly observe your child to ensure that they are taking their time with the questions. LevelSet will deliver the most accurate results when your child takes their time and gives their best effort.
- Let your child know they can stop LevelSet at any time to finish it later or tomorrow by exiting the program. LevelSet will pick up right where they left off.
- The test will stop when your child's Lexile score has been determined.

What happens when my child finishes LevelSet?

- Any lessons assigned to your child in Achieve3000 Literacy will be delivered at your child's precise Lexile level, as established by LevelSet.
- Your child can find their Lexile measure by going to the Career Center in Achieve3000 Literacy at the top of their screen.
