

# National Honor Society

## Application Procedure:

1. In late August or early September the registrar will give the advisor a complete list of all juniors and seniors with a cumulative GPA of a 3.5 or higher.
  - a. Membership is only extended to students the first quarter of the school year
2. The advisor will give a letter to each student telling them what is necessary to complete an application for membership.
  - a. Website: [www.keaauhs.com](http://www.keaauhs.com)
    - i. Click on the tab that says clubs
    - ii. Click student tab then click NHS
3. If interested, the student will complete the entire online application located at the National Honor Society page.
4. The applicant will then print three (3) copies and with a parent signature on each, turn into the advisor on the specified date on the application form.
5. Acceptance letters will be passed out to their Social Studies Teacher.
  - a. If do not have a Social Studies class, contact the head advisor.

## Reviewing Process:

1. Once receiving the applications, the advisor will white out the names and parent signatures of two of the copies.
2. The advisor will then select 5 teachers on campus.
3. They will then review each application and grade it according to a rubric provided by National Honor Society.
4. The rubric is then given to the advisor who will add up the tally marks.
5. Student must be a Junior or Senior in Kea'au High School for at least one school semester.

**\*Membership is awarded to as many students with the earned score that is required for acceptance\***

## Acceptance:

1. Letters will be given out from Social Studies Teacher.

2. The student will have to see the advisor on the specified date in the letter to find out information about installation and membership.
